-- No, there are eight of them who make it – definitely eight. And it's not Talladega, it's elsewhere in the state.

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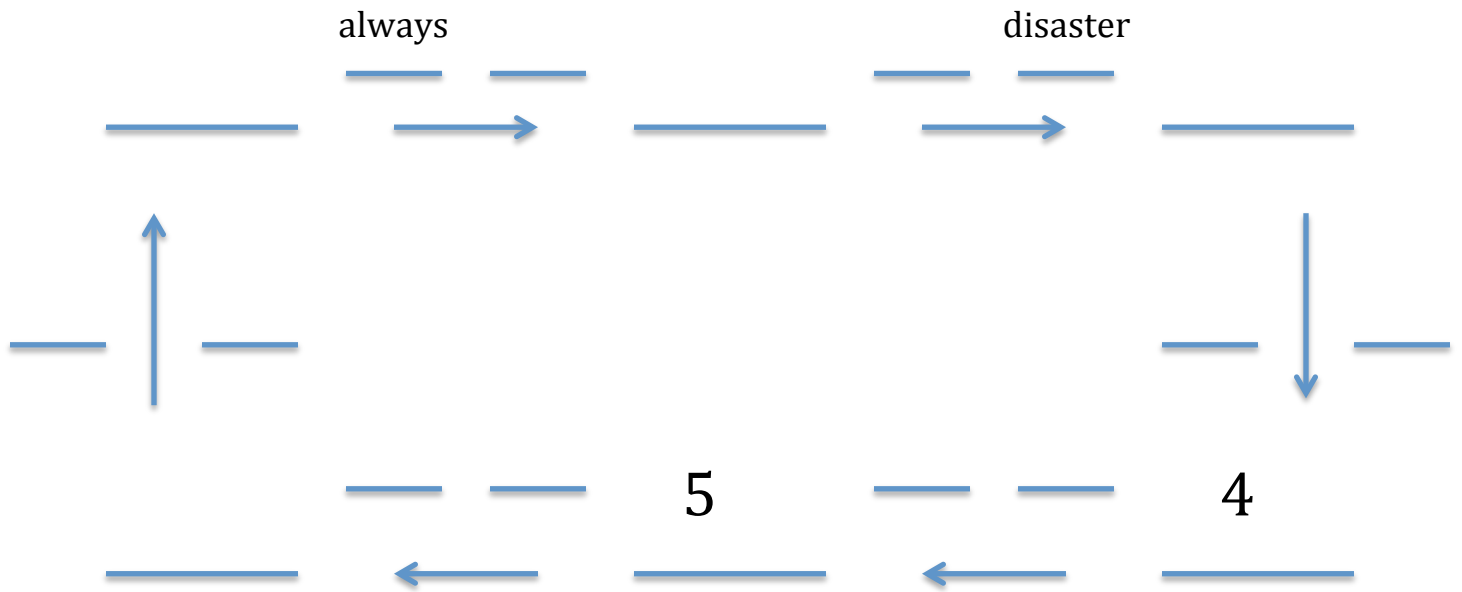

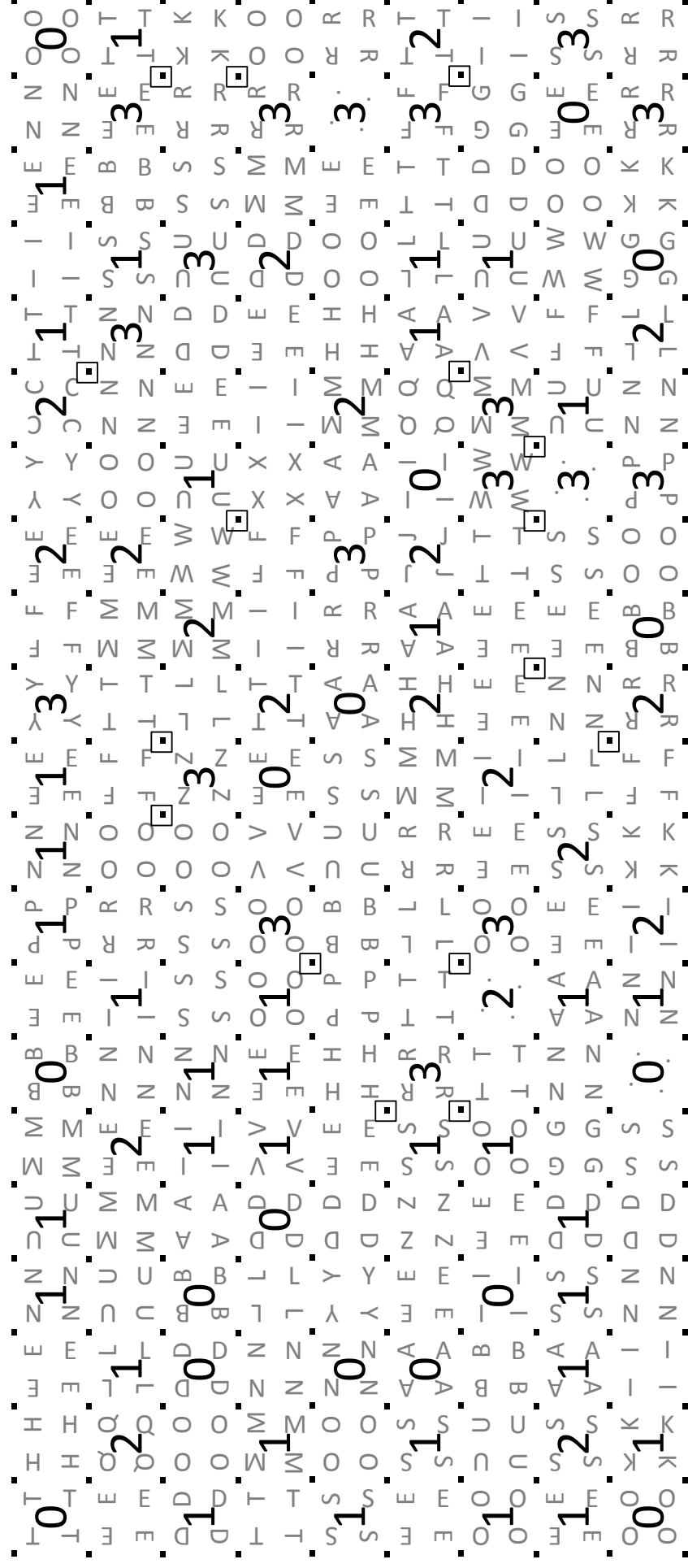

FBPH 2014 / Loop-T-Loop

This is a slitherlink puzzle (search for it) with a twist. Instead of a single closed loop, you will be creating a series of sub-loops. Each subloop will be connected to the main loop in exactly two places by “T” junctions, that is, dots which are connected in exactly three directions as opposed to the usual two. All of the T junctions are designated by an additional box around the dot.

If you’ve never done a slitherlink before, searching for “slitherlink pattern guide” may help.
