- A way to style your websites

```
<link rel = "stylesheet" type="text/css" href="style.css">
```

The Anatomy of CSS Selectors

```
SELECTOR {  
    RULE: VALUE;  
    RULE: VALUE;  
    RULE: VALUE;  
}
```

Example

```
body {  
    background-color: lightblue;  
    font-weight: bold;  
}
```

Types of Selectors

- tag
- .class
 - Can apply to multiply things
 - class="class1 class2"
- #id
 - Must be unique
 - id="awesome"

Examples

#dog

#cat

.pets

p

p.pets

Relationships of Tags

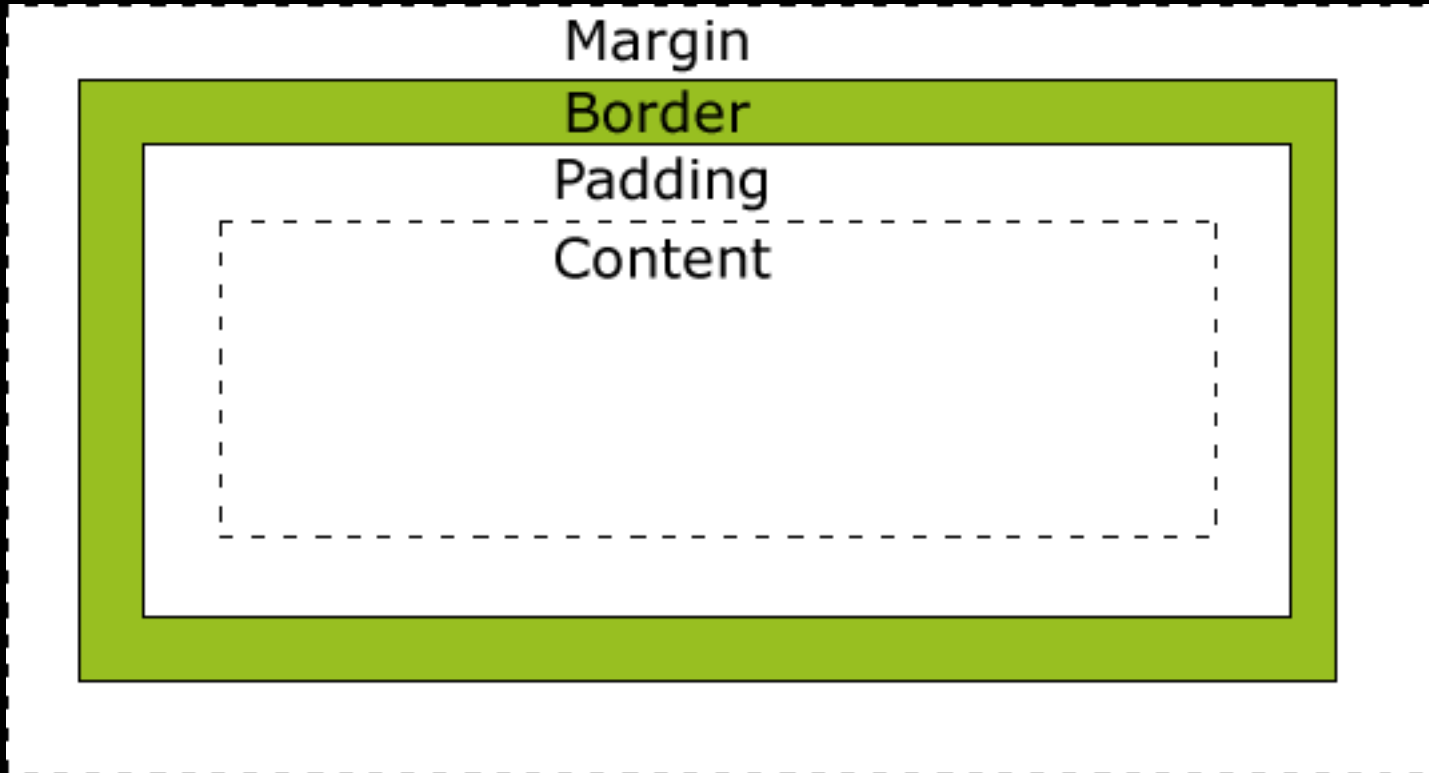
PARENT-SELECTOR CHILD-SELECTOR

“Select all of the children within the parent”

Example:

```
body .navbar .button
```
